**FORT LAUDERDALE, F.L., November 10, 2008** --*Bonnet House Museum & Gardens* is offering two Watercolor workshops this season. Each six week workshop will run from 9:30am – 12:30pm on Wednesdays with the first session beginning on January 14 and running thru February 18 and the second from February 25 thru April 1.

“Bonnet House is the ideal setting for painting outdoors. The main house emulates a sense of charm and the surrounding grounds are home to a variety of tropical plants and wildlife native to Florida” states Bonnet House Fine Artist and watercolorist, Karen Eskesen who returns once again to teach this very popular outdoor painting class. Karen comes from Colby College and has studied at the Brooklyn Museum Art School and Skowhegan School. She has been painting for over 30 years and has exhibited her works throughout the world. Karen specializes in watercolors, still life, botanicals, and classical Greek sculpture. The class covers traditional techniques of realism in watercolor; line drawing using positive and negative space; mixing colors from the primary colors; observing light, shadow and volume.
