Acrylic class Art Supplies:

Teacher- Nia Nakis

Paints: Preferred Brands, Liquitex, or Golden. (Heavy body)

Titanium White

Cadmium red light

Cadmium yellow medium

Ultramarine blue

Cerulean blue

Alizarin crimson

Sap Green

Yellow Ochre

Primary colors red, blue and yellow can create other colors, if budget is tight, you can start with the primaries plus white. The above list is a sufficient one for start. *Can add more colors later to suit your preferences*.

Spray water bottle (can be an empty Windex bottle)

Palette for acrylics size 11x15, "Sta –Wet" (paper and sponge included)

Old rugs for whipping the brush

A container for water to use for rinsing your brush between different colors, etc.

Brushes: Should be natural bristles

Round medium size, Flat #8, Bright #6, Filbert #12, rigger (for delicate lines)

oil brushes work for acrylics too. (Not watercolor brushes)

Other useful things to have is a ruler, **T-square**, **pencil**, **scissors** (optional)

Canvas sizes: 16x20 and or smaller. Canvas panels are also good for beginners
