Bonnet House, built in 1920, was the winter home of artists Frederic Clay Bartlett and Evelyn Fortune Bartlett. The home contains many whimsical decorative touches and is located on thirty-five secluded acres between the Intracoastal Waterway and the Atlantic Ocean on Fort Lauderdale Beach.

Today Bonnet House is a historic house museum that welcomes over 70,000 visitors annually for tours, art exhibits, and private events. Education programs focusing on art and local and natural history are offered for children and adults. Bonnet House is the only cultural organization in Fort Lauderdale's beach area. The estate is listed on the National Register of Historic Places and is designated as a historic landmark by the City of Fort Lauderdale.

Evelyn Fortune Bartlett, the former owner of Bonnet House, loved orchids and amassed an incredible collection of these beautiful plants over the sixty-plus years she wintered here. Today, Bonnet House has over 1,000 orchids, one of the largest orchid collections in the southeast United States. This collection has inspired an annual festival featuring orchids and other plant vendors, purveyors of garden art and tools, live music, and food vendors, all in the tranquil beauty of the Bonnet House grounds.

*Festival Facts*

- **April 5<sup>TH</sup> and 6<sup>TH</sup> on the Bonnet House grounds | 9:00AM – 4:00PM both days**
- Admission to the event is \$25 and includes:
  - Access to over thirty vendors selling a wide variety of orchids, garden supplies and art
  - Lectures and workshops on orchid care and gardening
  - Access to food trucks with a variety of cuisines for purchase
  - Bloody Mary, Mimosas, wine, and beer for purchase
- **Early Bird:** Purchase tickets online by March 15th and receive a \$5 discount per ticket
- Over 5,000 people typically attend the Festival.
- The entire grounds are open where guests can enjoy Bonnet House's Forest Forms sculpture exhibit
- **NEW for 2025:** Self-guided tours of the historic house are included in Festival admission.
